

North Angola – *Discovery Tour*

This sample itinerary explores the highlights of Northern Angola, combining dramatic landscapes, rich history, rural life and wild coastal scenery. It is designed as an inspirational journey and can be fully adapted according to travel dates and personal interests.



Day 1 – Luanda → Massangano

Arrival in Luanda and meet with the local guide before departing northwards. Leaving the capital behind, the road quickly reveals a more rural Angola, with villages, rivers and open landscapes. Arrival in Massangano, one of the oldest colonial settlements in the country, located on the banks of the Kwanza River. Time to relax and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere after the journey.



Day 2 – Massangano → Calandula

After breakfast, departure towards Calandula through scenic countryside. The drive offers insight into daily Angolan life, with farming areas and local villages along the way. Arrival near Calandula in the afternoon, close to one of Angola's most impressive natural landmarks. The surrounding area is lush and green, creating a striking contrast with the power of the waterfalls.



Day 3 - Calandula

Full day dedicated to exploring the spectacular Calandula Falls, among the largest waterfalls in Africa. Several viewpoints allow appreciation of the immense scale and raw energy of the falls. Walks around the site offer different perspectives and photo opportunities, while the sound of cascading water dominates the landscape. This is one of the true highlights of Northern Angola.



Day 4 – Pedras Negras → N'Dalatando

Departure towards the legendary Pedras Negras de Pungo Andongo. These monumental black rock formations rise dramatically from the plains and are surrounded by myths, legends and historical significance linked to the ancient Kingdom of Ndongo. After exploring the site, continue to N'Dalatando, a town set amidst rolling green hills and former coffee plantations.



Day 5 – Conda

The journey continues south through fertile regions and changing scenery. The road crosses agricultural zones, rivers and forested areas, offering a deeper look into Angola's natural diversity. Arrival in Conda, a quiet and remote area surrounded by nature, ideal for slowing down and enjoying the peaceful environment.



Day 6 – Conda

Day dedicated to exploring the Conda region and its surroundings. Time for gentle walks in nature, encounters with local communities and observation of rural life. This day offers an authentic insight into Angola away from the main routes, focusing on simplicity, landscapes and human connections.



Day 7 – Conda → Cabo Ledo

After breakfast, departure towards the Atlantic coast. As the journey progresses, the scenery gradually shifts from inland greenery to coastal landscapes. Arrival in Cabo Ledo, a wild and unspoiled coastal area known for its dramatic cliffs, long beaches and relaxed atmosphere influenced by the ocean.



Day 8 – Cabo Ledo / Quicama

Free day in Cabo Ledo to enjoy the coastline at your own pace. Time to relax on the beach, explore the rugged coastal scenery or simply enjoy the laid-back ambiance of the area. Optional activities can be arranged depending on interests, including safaris, beach walks or ocean-based experiences.



Day 9 – Miradouro da Lua → Luanda

Departure along the coast with a stop at the iconic Miradouro da Lua. This spectacular viewpoint reveals otherworldly formations shaped by erosion, creating a landscape reminiscent of the moon. Continue back to Luanda, where the contrasts between modern city life and historical heritage become apparent.



Day 10 – Luanda

Depending on flight schedule, city exploration of Luanda. Possibility to discover key landmarks, cultural sites and seaside areas, offering a final glimpse into Angola's vibrant capital before departure.
